Dear Emergency Medical Services Provider:

The New Jersey Department of Health and Senior Services, Office of Emergency Medical Services (OEMS), has implemented a web-based Learning Management System (LMS) that includes all New Jersey EMS certifications and OEMS approved EMS courses. The LMS can be found at www.njoemscert.com. The LMS will enable you to:

- Update your personal contact information
- Search and register for OEMS approved CEU courses
- View your personal CEU status and print transcripts
- Complete all required recertification documentation

Enclosed is your new Certification/Endorsement card. This card replaces your current New Jersey EMS Certification/Endorsement card. The new card contains a six (6) digit ID number to replace the old nine (9) digit number. This number change is effective immediately. This new number is to be used for all EMS coursework and will also serve as your User ID to log in to the LMS website. Your password information is located to the right of your new certification card.

All New Jersey EMS certified personnel must complete a recertification form within 6 months of their expiration date. This form can be found on the LMS and should only be submitted once you have completed all requirements for recertification, and are within six (6) months of your expiration date. If you do not have computer access, please contact OEMS at (609)633-7777 to have a copy of this form mailed to you.
